SUBJECT: 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF SISTER CITY RELATIONS BETWEEN BURNABY

& KUSHIRO, JAPAN

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve \$8,000 in financial support for the Nikkei National Museum & Cultural Center to off-set costs related to celebrations and events planned for the 50th Anniversary of the Sister City relationship between Burnaby and Kushiro.

REPORT

Burnaby's sister city relationship with Kushiro, Japan was initiated by then Reeve Alan Emmott in 1965. At that time, delegates from the City of Kushiro visited Burnaby and an Exchange Affiliation Agreement was signed. In 1990, the Exchange Affiliation Agreement was renewed in celebration of the 25th Anniversary of the relationship. Throughout the past half-century, numerous exchanges have taken place in the fields of art and culture, education and sport that have resulted in deep ties between Burnaby and Kushiro that continue to this day.

In celebration of the 50th Anniversary milestone, the City of Burnaby will be hosting a delegation from Kushiro, Japan from 2015 July 7-11. Activities are being planned to recognize 50 years of ongoing relations between the cities of Burnaby and Kushiro.

The Nikkei National Museum & Cultural Center will play an important role along with the City of Burnaby in hosting the delegation from Kushiro and arranging activities to showcase the ties between these two countries and cities. Further, the Nikkei Matsuri Festival, hosted by the Nikkei Center in September, will highlight key exchanges and a chronological story of the Sister City relationship that will be available to the public.
