A) <u>Correspondence from the Mayor of Dura Municipality, State of Palestine</u> Re: Proposal for a Sister/Friendship City Relationship

Correspondence was received from the Mayor of Dura Municipality, State of Palestine proposing a Sister/Friendship City relationship with the City of Burnaby.
