REPORT

The 2014 Annual Capital Budget for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following project to be funded from Capital Reserves. To enable work to go ahead on this project, approval is requested to bring down a bylaw for funding.

1. Burnaby Art Gallery

\$20,000

To prepare plans and designs for the restoration of the Fireside Room, finishes, fixtures, adjacent storage area to improve space for programs and rentals.

Sufficient Capital Reserves are available to complete the above project in the 2014 Annual Capital Budget. It is recommended that Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$20,935 (inclusive of GST) from Capital Reserves to finance this project.
