Eagle Creek Salmon release: request to place signs on public property.

Eagle Creek Streamkeepers has arranged with Department of Fisheries and Oceans to release 50,000 Chum Salmon on Eagle Creek by Charles Rummel Park on April 18 from 10AM to about 1PM.

To advertise to local citizens, for participation in the release, we would request your approval to allow approximately 25 lawn signs to be placed on City Boulevards most in close proximity of the release. We would like to place the signs about one week in advance of the release. The signs will be removed after the event.

We also would like to invite the Mayor, Councillors, and City staff to come and release Chun fry into Eagle Creek.
