WHEREAS there is no known cause of, prevention of, or cure for multiple

sclerosis; and

organization in Canada that supports both MS research and services

for people with MS and their families; and

WHEREAS since 1948, the Multiple Sclerosis Society of Canada has provided

more than \$100 million for MS research; and is grateful for the dedication and commitment of it's supporters and volunteers that has

made this possible; and

WHEREAS BC will continue to led the way in multiple sclerosis research, through

one of the world's most renowned multiple sclerosis research

facilities at the University of British Columbia; and

WHEREAS together we will find ways to enhance the quality of lives for people

affected by multiple sclerosis and to find a cure to end MS;
