REPORT

Burnaby's sister city relationship with Kushiro, Japan was initiated by then Reeve Alan Emmott in 1965. At that time, delegates from the City of Kushiro visited Burnaby and an Exchange Affiliation Agreement was signed. In 1990, the Exchange Affiliation Agreement was renewed in celebration of the 25th Anniversary of the relationship. Throughout the past half-century, numerous exchanges have taken place in the fields of art and culture, education and sport that have resulted in deep ties between Burnaby and Kushiro that continue to this day.

In celebration of the 50th Anniversary milestone, the City of Burnaby will be hosting a delegation from Kushiro, Japan from 2015 July 7-11. Activities are being planned to recognize 50 years of ongoing relations between the cities of Burnaby and Kushiro.
