NOTE: The Engineering Department is supportive of the Burnaby Gogo's request for temporary signs on street boulevards subject to further review and confirmation of the specific locations and number of signs. Council approval is recommended. Some of the requested locations are on school or park property and they will be redirected accordingly.

We are writing on behalf of the Burnaby Gogos. We are a charitable organization of grandmothers raising funds in support of African grandmothers who are raising their grandchildren who have been orphaned by AIDS. We make our contributions through the Stephen Lewis Foundation.

On December 6^{th} , 2015, we will be holding our third annual Swags & Bags sale at Deer Lake United Church. In an attempt to reach more Burnaby residents, we would like to put up signs $(3' \times 4')$ at four significant intersections and we understand that Council's permission is required.

The sites proposed are:-

- 1)- on the chain link fence at the corner of Canada Way and Edmonds
- 2)-on the chain link fence at the junction of Canada Way and Royal Oak
- 3)- on the chain link fence at the corner of Royal Oak and Dover
- 4)- on a tree just east of Shadbolt at the junction of Kensington and Canada Way

All of these would be put up after Dec. 1st and would be removed late on Dec. 6th.

We would also like to display a number of small sale signs, as most charities do for their functions, on the day of the sale itself. None of these proposed signs would impede drivers' visibility and they would not damage any property.
