SUBJECT: 2016 MARCH - PARKS, RECREATION & CULTURAL SERVICES CAPITAL FUNDING BYLAW

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- **1. THAT** the expenditure of \$425,000 from the 2016 Provisional Financial Plan for the projects outlined in this report be approved.
- **2. THAT** Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$444,860 (inclusive of GST) from Capital Reserves to finance these projects.

REPORT

The 2016 Provisional Financial Plan for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following 6 projects to be funded from Capital Reserves. To enable work to go ahead on these projects, approval is requested to bring down a bylaw for funding.

1. Burnaby Art Gallery (DPY.0064) \$30,000 Supply and install program operation items, replace gallery display/AV supports and construct new built in cabinets. \$50,000 2. Shadbolt Centre for the Arts (DPX.0148) Replace, supply and install audio, video and scenic theatre equipment including energy efficient LED technology. 3. Burnaby Mountain Golf Course (DPW.0248) \$50,000 Phase 1 of Tee/Green reconstruction for Holes 14, 15, 16 to include a new sub-base, drainage system, irrigation to improve playability and general conditions.

- Barrier Gates and Bleachers (DPW.0266) Replacement of barrier gates and bleachers at various park sites \$70,000 and sports fields in the park system.
- 5. Park Trail Systems (DPW.0261) \$100,000 Reconstruction of trail segments to include grade changes, trail, widening, slope stabilization , excavation and rebuilding washouts.
- 6. Vehicle Purchase (DPZ.0019)

\$125,000

Purchase of additional vehicles to reduce response time and improve maintenance standards. Items include a crew cab pickup with trailer and two riding mowers for grass crews and a mini pickup for irrigation crews.

Sufficient Capital Reserves are available to complete the above projects in the 2016 Provisional Financial Plan. It is recommended that Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$444,860 (inclusive of GST) from Capital Reserves to finance these projects.
