1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$28,000 be awarded to Burnaby Community Services for core programs and publications in 2016.

Programs and services include: the Burnaby Camping Bureau (\$6,000), various publications (\$9,000), Seniors Transportation (\$8,000), the Burnaby Christmas Bureau (\$5,000).
