An application request for \$4,000 has been received from the Permai BC Association for the Alun-Alun, Indonesian Archipelago Night 2016 August 13 at the Burnaby Lake Clubhouse. Alun-Alun is a Javanese word for a large open common space found in villages, towns or cities in Indonesia that functions as the heart of the city were public spectacle, celebrations and entertainment are usually held. With the spirit of unity and sense of community, the Permai BC Association is planning a night market to celebrate the 71st anniversary of Indonesia's Independence typically held on August 17th. Activities will include cultural performances, entertainment, Indonesian food and a market place.

PERMAI BC is a non-profit and non-political organization with missions to foster closer cooperation among Indonesians in BC, and to introduce Indonesian arts and culture to Canadians in general.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has shown evidence that they have the capacity to coordinate the event. Festivals Burnaby funds would be allocated toward eligible project expenses related to programming, marketing/promotions and administration.
