An application request for \$4,000 has been received from the Korean Traditional Arts Society (KTAS) for the International Traditional Drum and Dance Festival 2016 June 29 at the James Cowan Theatre, Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. The festival celebrates both Canada Day and the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Expo '86 and will feature a program of multicultural drum and dance performances.

The Korean Traditional Art Society is dedicated to promoting the diverse forms and expressions of Korean traditional culture, to increasing community awareness of Korean culture and to encouraging and facilitating cultural exchanges and collaboration between Canada and Korea. The application has been completed in full and the applicant has shown evidence that they can coordinate the event. Festivals Burnaby funds would be allocated toward eligible project expenses related to programming, marketing/promotions and administration.
