This morning, I read an article on the CBC saying that presently an insecticide called Merit is being promoted as a way of killing chafer beetles. However, this insecticide is also directly harmful to bees and various other helpful insects. We desperately need to reduce the use of insecticides that reduce bee populations.

The EU has already banned the use of neonicotinoid pesticide because of how bad it is for bees, and I believe the cities of Vancouver and Burnaby should follow suit. I'm also going to send an email to the appropriate legislators for British Columbia and Canada, but I thought I'd send my concerns in directly.
