Sgt. Selvage from Langley attended our CPAC meeting to learn how CPAC operates.

District 3 is purchasing a tent with the RCMP and CPO branding built in.

The Police report indicated that there has been a noticeable increase in homelessness recently, especially with the recent demo-viction in District 4.

The CPO reported that the volunteer numbers are now at a healthy level and is still recruiting. The team is currently partnering with ICBC to focus on distracted driving and Cell Watch.

A member noticed an increase in poor behaviour among the youth at Edmonds Community Centre, possibly related to the approach of Halloween. A suggestion was to contact the School Liaison Officer.

Our youth member is still looking into the feasibility of starting a CPAC style group at the high school level in Edmonds area.

Two members are attending the BC Crime Prevention symposium on Oct 28/29, 2016.

We will be participating in the Festival of Lights at Edmonds Community Centre on Nov 26.
