An application request for \$20,000 has been received from the Latinos in Action Society for the Latin Reggae Summer Fest on 2017 August 12-13 at Swangard Stadium. The two day festival will bring a new celebration of international artists (from Mexico, Jamaica and Spain), national artists, local bands, market vendors and food trucks together in metro Vancouver.

After the 2015 event, Latinos in Action sunset their Latin Summer Fest at Trout Lake Park and is reimagining a new fusion type festival of Latin Reggae music for the proposed 2017 event at Swangard Stadium, with plenty of interactive audience opportunities to engage, educate and entertain.

Latinos in Action was founded in 2001 following the El Salvador Earthquakes. The organization is made up of individuals and businesses that are committed to intercultural harmony and the cultural education and promotion of Latin Caribbean and Afro culture. The mandate of the organization is to promote intercultural exchanges, to foster community engagement and pluralism, to promote advocacy and awareness, and to promote the value of family. Latinos in Action works with many organizations and over the last 15 years has established many festivals and events within Vancouver and Surrey.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has shown evidence that they have the capacity to coordinate the event. Festivals Burnaby funds would be allocated toward eligible project expenses related to programming, marketing/promotions and administration.
