An application request for \$4,000 has been received from the Rotary Club of Burnaby for the Rotary Gravity Grand Prix 2017 on 2017 June 10 on Sterling Avenue around Deer Lake Park. After a 16 year hiatus, the Rotary Club of Burnaby is resurrecting the Gravity Grand Prix, a one day community event featuring soap box derby races, family activities, entertainment, concessions and community displays.
