An application request for \$4,500 has been received from the Burnaby Arts Council for the 46th Annual Deer Lake Craft Festival on 2017 November 24-26 at Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. This 3 day festival includes a variety of performance artists scheduled throughout the weekend and a maximum of 50 artisans selling high quality arts and crafts. This festival provides an opportunity for performers in the community to showcase their talents.

Burnaby Arts Council was established in 1970 with the organizations mission to support, promote and expand the arts in Burnaby.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has shown evidence that they have the capacity to coordinate the event. Festivals Burnaby funds would be allocated toward eligible project expenses related to programming, marketing/promotions and administration.
