An application request for \$8,200 has been received from Permai BC Association for Festival Alun-Alun 2017 to be held on 2017 October 14 at Nikkei National Museum & Cultural Centre. Alun-Alun is a Javanese word for a large open common space found in villages, towns or cities in Indonesia that functions as the heart of the city where public spectacle, celebrations and entertainment are usually held. This festival will showcase traditional Indonesian dances, music arts and crafts and cuisine. To celebrate the large ethnic diversity in Burnaby the association will extend invitations to engage other community/ethnic groups to participate at the festival through performances, booths and exhibits.
