SUBJECT: BURNABY TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE – PHASE 1

At its meeting of June 27, 2017, Council authorized staff to undertake public consultation in support of a renewed *Burnaby Transportation Plan*. The focus of the consultation is to get feedback on the draft vision, themes and goals that would form the basis for the renewed Plan (see *attached* poster). The purpose of this memo is to advise Committee members of the opportunities to participate in the Plan renewal process.

Public consultation began in mid-August, and will extend to 2017 November 30. Public input is being sought on-line, by mail, and at public events.
