For many years our co-op has been asking for a traffic light on Cariboo drive and Cariboo Rd to no avail. They did put in a crosswalk in front of the Salvation Army church (which no one pays attention to and a pedestrian was seriously injured) but most people try to cross at the corner as it is closer for them. There is constantly serious accidents on this corner although no fatalities! Is that what it has to take? I am so tired of waiting 5-10 minutes to turn left on Cariboo. I feel I'm playing Russian roulette on a daily basis and wondering when my luck is up! The traffic since the tolling of the Port Mann bridge has increased enormously as everyone is using Cariboo as a way to get to the Patullo bridge. The cars go up and down at a high rate of speed and even when moving slowly, won't let cars merge into the flow of traffic! They have a traffic light on Halston court and Government St, with more residents, but with the danger of crossing this busy street does our community mean less or again is the city waiting for a fatality? Everyone I have talked to, fire ,police,mail delivery, city of Burnaby workers, ambulance, garbage and recycling pick-up, have voiced their concerns about this. Between the hours of 3-7 most people won't even attempt to leave and go anywhere as it is almost impossible to get off our street! This traffic light will also reduce the speed of traffic and make this road safer for everyone! Please consider this request as the lives of Burnaby citizens is at stake.
