CRPS / RSD AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS

Complex Regional Pain Syndrome (CRPS), also known as Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy (RSD) is a nerve disorder that causes chronic pain, and

WHEREAS	The symptoms of CRPS/RSD are often described as a burning that is out of proportion to the severity of the initial injury and can include extreme sensitivity to the touch and swelling; and
WHEREAS	While CRPS/RSD was first identified during the Civil War, it remains a poorly understood condition. There is no cure; and
WHEREAS	The National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke and other institutes of the National Institutes of Health support research relating to CRPS/RSD; and
WHEREAS	Members of the CRPS/RSD community will be spreading awareness in November; and
WHEREAS	On November 6, 2017, members of the CRPS/RSD community will be celebrating the third annual Color The World Orange Day to spread awareness of this poorly understood pain disorder.
