SUBJECT: BC HYDRO PROPOSED STATUTORY RIGHT-OF-WAY - WILLINGDON
LINEAR PARK
PURPOSE: To seek Council authorization for the granting of a proposed statutory right-of-way.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. **THAT** Council authorize the granting of the proposed statutory right-of-way in favour of BC Hydro, as outlined in this report.
2. **THAT** Council authorize Legal and Engineering to prepare the required statutory right-of-way plan.

REPORT

BACKGROUND

The civil work for the Willingdon Linear Park is nearing completion. In order to complete the pedestrian lighting for the proposed multi-use trail, BC Hydro has indicated a requirement of a statutory right-of-way at 1040 Willingdon Avenue (City owned property) to accommodate the placement of a service that will energize the pedestrian lighting. The location of the statutory right-of-way is shown on *Attachment #1* attached. Engineering has reviewed this matter and it has been determined that there are no concerns to granting the necessary right-of-way.

RECOMMENDATION

The proposed service is essential for the Willingdon Linear Park lighting to be energized. Therefore, it is recommended that Council authorize the granting of the proposed statutory right-of-way in favour of BC Hydro, as outlined in this report and that Council authorize Engineering to prepare the required statutory right-of-way plan.

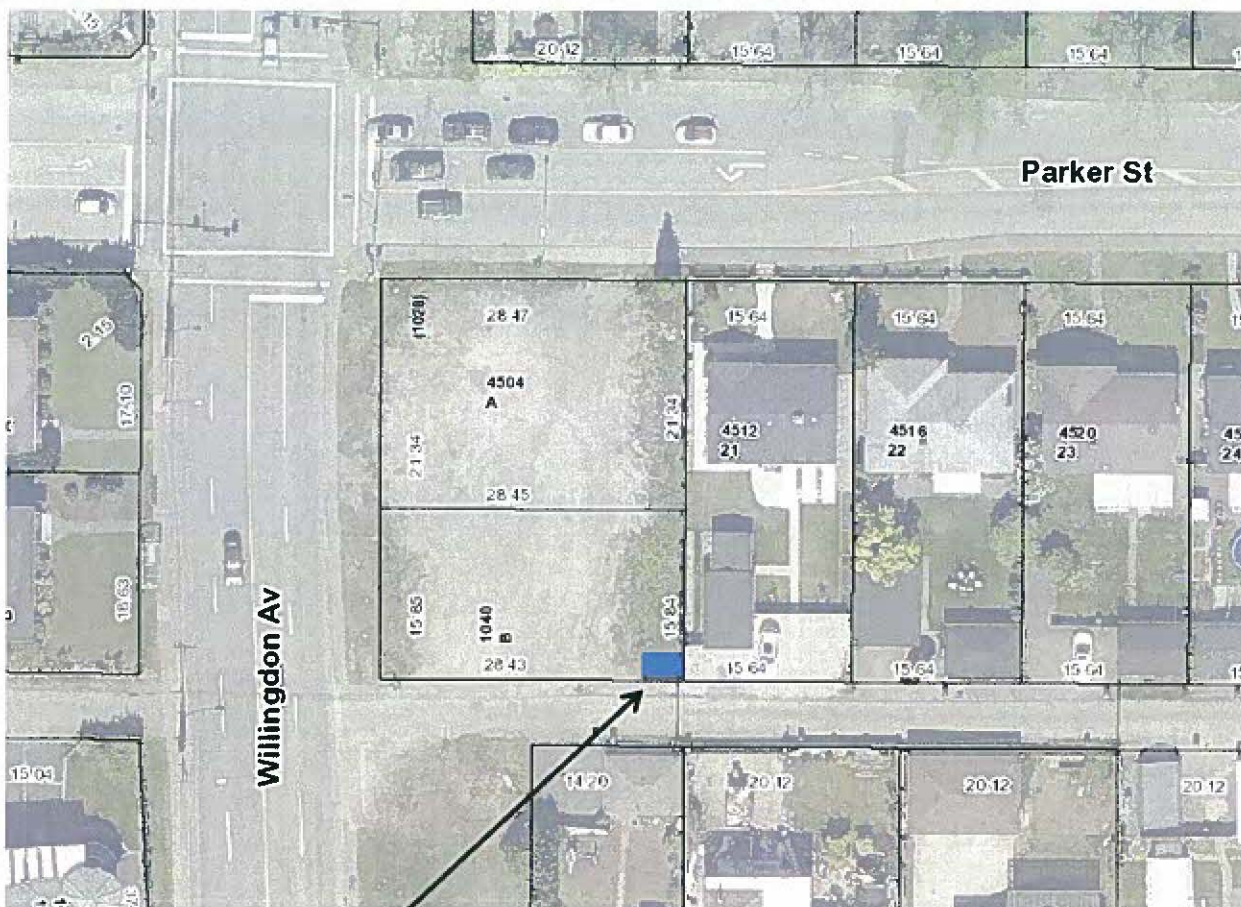
