The City has had an agreement with the Trustees of the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club for the last thirty years. The Club is responsible to manage and fund their operations, maintain the interior of the facility for reasonable wear and tear, as well as provide this activity to residents of Burnaby, with payment of \$1 per year to the City. Club membership remains consistent at 28 - 30 people. The Club is a key member of the B.C. Horseshoe Association and a member of Horseshoe Canada. Tournaments are hosted throughout the season from the end of April till the end of September. The Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club continues to provide a valuable service to the community, and they continue to operate within the terms and conditions of their licence.

The terms of the licence have been reviewed with members of the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club for the new five year term:

- 1. The trustees for the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club will be Bob Salisbury, President; Diane Dushesne, Treasurer; and Scott O'Neil, Vice President.
- 2. The new term for the licence will be for five years commencing on the 15th day of April, 2018 and ending on the 14th day of April, 2023.
- 3. Insurance requirements will be amended to comply with City standards.

It is recommended that approval be given for the renewal of the licence agreement as outlined in this report.
