- Purple Day is an annual global awareness day for epilepsy; and
- Epilepsy affects nearly 300,000 people in Canada, three million WHEREAS people in the United States and over 50 million people worldwide; and
- These statistics exceed those stricken with multiple sclerosis, **WHEREAS** cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy and Parkinson's disease combined; and
 - Many people living with epilepsy still face barriers due to a lack of **WHEREAS** awareness about the disorder; and
- **WHEREAS** Public misconceptions all too often create stigma and social isolation which has a devastating effect on the self esteem of children who have epilepsy; and
- Purple Day raises awareness of epilepsy and supports those WHEREAS affected by the disorder.
