Summary report for May and June.

Our May meeting lacked the members attendance so we focused on recruitment of new members for CPAC 3. A poster will be created to distribute to the Towers and Multi unit apartments, to the Library and nearby businesses.

A member was concerned about the difficulty of turning left when there is no green arrow light at the intersections with 3 lanes. It was suggested that probably the sensor does not pick up when there is not enough traffic on that lane.
