INTERNATIONAL DAY OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

WHEREAS There are an estimated 370 million indigenous peoples in the world,

living across 90 countries; and

WHEREAS 1.67 million people in Canada self-identify as being of indigenous

descent, including approximately 4,000 Burnaby community members;

and

WHEREAS Every year on August 9th the United Nations observes the 'International

Day of Indigenous Peoples' in recognition of the unique cultures and

contributions of indigenous peoples; and

WHEREAS The City of Burnaby encourages the Federal Government of Canada to

fully implement the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, in accordance with the Canadian constitution.

NOW THEREFORE I, DEREK R. CORRIGAN, MAYOR OF BURNABY, DO
HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 9 AS

"INTERNATIONAL DAY OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES"
