## Douglas Road at Hardwick Street: Pedestrian Lines and Students Cross Signs Needed

Dear Honourable Burnaby City Mayor,

We are citizens of Burnaby City. Our two children and three more other children living EAST to the intersection of Douglas Road at Hardwick St, are attending Douglas Road Elementary school. They have to walk cross Douglas Road every morning and afternoon. It is quite dangerous to the children especially in morning time of rainy and winter season, because vehicles are all rushing through the area on Douglas Road during the time but there is no traffic light, neither pedestrian cross lines nor any young students cross sign there. We appeal to your honourable mayor to help schedule as soon as possible for,

- 1. Painting pedestrian cross lines on Douglas Road in that intersection for the purpose of young student children to cross to attend elementary school safer.
- 2. Installing young students cross signs along Douglas Road near the intersection.

As you can see from the attached map, there is no other convenient alternative path for those young children to attend school without crossing Douglas Road in that intersection, since there is no pedestrian walk path along the east side of the road around the intersection for students to walk to the nearest point with traffic light to cross to school. It is unsafe to walk along the east side. And it is very likely to be poured by splashing dirt water by full speed vehicles in raining season.

And you can see from the attached photos, both children and accompanying adult were panic to cross there in the school morning time but they have to cross. It is really unsafe for those at least five young students who are aging from grade 1 to grade 5.

While I am putting efforts to coordinate under the school PAC to help the situation such as to do volunteer temporary traffic guard there, I do hope the pedestrian cross lines and students cross signs requested above can be finished before the coming winter.
