- 1 sign at Deer Lake Park Way and Gilpin/Deer Lake Ave.
- 3. 1 sign on the green strip, on Kensington, outside the Scandinavian Centre.
- 4. 1 sign on Canada Way near Burris.
- 5. 1 sign on Canada Way near Norland.
- 6. 1 sign on Canada Way near Imperial
- 7. 1 sign on Deer Lake Parkway near the entrance to Green Tree Village.
- 8. 1 sign on the centre boulevard on Royal Oak between Deer Lake Park Way and Buxton.

These smaller signs would not impede driver's visibility nor would they damage any property. All signs would be put up after November 17th and would be removed no later than November 27th.
