SUBJECT: **PARKS AND PUBLIC SPACES AT UNIVERCITY AND
LIGHT POLLUTION FROM DEVELOPMENTS DUE TO BUILDING
DESIGN**
(ITEM NO. 5(A), DELEGATION, COUNCIL 2018 DECEMBER 10)

Burnaby City Council, at the Open Council meeting held on 2018 December 10, heard from delegation Gary Wong regarding the need for a dog park at UniverCity. Mr. Wong also expressed concern with light pollution resulting from the existing building design of two structures at Parcel 18 and requested Council consider creating a bylaw to reduce light pollution and incorporate related measures in the City's Environmental Sustainability Strategy.

Arising from discussion, Council adopted the following motions:

1. THAT the request for a dog park in the UniverCity area be **REFERRED** to the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission; and
2. THAT the issues raised regarding light pollution be **REFERRED** to staff for report.
