SUBJECT: PARKS AND PUBLIC SPACES AT UNIVERCITY AND LIGHT POLLUTION FROM DEVELOPMENTS DUE TO BUILDING DESIGN (ITEM NO. 5(A), DELEGATION, COUNCIL 2018 DECEMBER 10)

Burnaby City Council, at the Open Council meeting held on 2018 December 10, heard from delegation Gary Wong regarding the need for a dog park at UniverCity. Mr. Wong also expressed concern with light pollution resulting from the existing building design of two structures at Parcel 18 and requested Council consider creating a bylaw to reduce light pollution and incorporate related measures in the City's Environmental Sustainability Strategy.

Arising from discussion, Council adopted the following motions:

- 1. THAT the request for a dog park in the UniverCity area be **REFERRED** to the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission; and
- 2. THAT the issues raised regarding light pollution be **REFERRED** to staff for report.
