REPORT

INTRODUCTION

A request to restrict vehicle traffic on City streets to alleviate potential traffic congestion during special events in Deer Lake Park has been received from Cory Philley, Theatre & Facility Services Coordinator from Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

DISCUSSION

The Shadbolt Centre for the Arts has submitted their 2019 schedule of Burnaby Concerts in Deer Lake Park. The following is a list of the concerts, dates and road closure times for the requested road closures:

1. 31th Annual Vancouver Symphony Orchestra – Symphony in the Park

Saturday, June 29 5:00pm to 11:00pm Sunday, June 30 5:00pm to 11:00pm

2. 20th Annual Burnaby Blues & Roots Festival

Saturday, August 10 2:00pm to 11:00pm

3. Live Nation Concert – The National

Wednesday, August 28 5:00pm to 11:00pm

4. Vampire Weekend Concert

Wednesday, September 25 5:00pm to 11:00pm

Nearby residents and businesses in the Deer Lake Park area will be receiving written notification about these upcoming events.

In order to alleviate potential traffic congestion, Deer Lake Ave at Deer Lake Pkwy will be closed in the eastbound direction for 2 hours prior to the start of each event (see attached map). City staff and Coast Mountain Bus Company will be coordinating their efforts to ensure that the needs of residents, businesses, organizers and patrons are safely accommodated.

As these are City events, liability insurance is not required.

The organizer is aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
- 2. That the organizer has agreed to monitor all barricades for the duration of the road closure.

- 3. That the organizer is responsible for arranging for certified traffic control persons to control traffic at Deer Lake Avenue and Deer Lake Parkway.
