REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission meetings are currently held at 7:00 p.m. Council and all other Committees meet no later than 6:00 p.m.

In an effort to streamline processes and to be consistent with Council and other Committees, it is recommended that the Commission meeting time be changed to 6:00 p.m. If the recommendation is approved, the Commission Policy Manual section 10 will be updated to reflect the new time.

Section 35(1) of the Burnaby Procedure Bylaw allows for the Chair to change the time of the meeting although it is usually used on an as required basis.

• 35. (1) The chair of a committee or commission may cancel a meeting, call an additional meeting or change the time or place of a meeting of that committee or commission. (BYLAW #13461)

As the requested change would be a permanent one, Commission and Council approval is required.
