INTRODUCTION

A request to use City streets in support of a fundraising event on Thursday, 2019 June 06 has been received from Mischa Greenwood, Gilmore Community School Coordinator. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

DISCUSSION

Gilmore Community School is hosting its 12th Biennial Spring Fair to raise money to purchase new resources and equipment for the school and after hour's programs and services to the Heights Community. This event is open to the whole community with an expected attendance of over 1,500 people between 4:00 pm & 9:00 pm on Thursday June 06. The event requires the closure of Dundas St & Triumph St between Carleton & Gilmore from 1:00 pm to 10:00 pm to reduce congestion and provide a safety buffer around the school where all activities are planned (See *Attachment #1*).

The organizers have polled and received approval from the impacted residents of their proposed event.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshal or organizer.
- 2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
- 3. That the organizer has agreed to monitor all barricades for the duration of the road closure.
- That all emergency and transit services are advised of the event.
- 5. That the road closures be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the City of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
- 6. That a signed copy of the "City of Burnaby Permit For Short Term Use and Occupancy Of City Lands" be received no later than one week prior to the event.
