REPORT**INTRODUCTION**

A request to use City streets for a Grand Opening & Neighbourhood Car Show on Saturday, 2019 July 27 between 10:00 am and 6:00pm has been received from Jeffrey Tremblay, Service Manager of The Garage (R & F Motors Ltd). Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

POLICY SECTION

The Grand Opening & Neighbourhood Car Show is aligned with the City of Burnaby's Corporate Strategic Plan by supporting the following goals and sub-goals of the Plan.

DISCUSSION

The Garage (R & F Motors Ltd) has recently moved their family business of 4 generations from Vancouver to Burnaby. They are proud of their accomplishments of the family owned business that began in 1934 and wish to celebrate this with their clients of old & new. Their Grand Opening will include an open house, promotional displays and a car show. Neighbouring automotive businesses will also be participating in the car show.

The Garage is requesting the closure of Shirley Avenue from Beresford Street to Dorset Street (see *attachment*) on Saturday, 2019 July 27 between 10:00 am and 6:00 pm which includes set up and take down. The actual event is from 12 noon to 4:00 pm. The Garage has consulted with all of the businesses on Shirley Avenue within the road closure and they are all supportive of this request.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
3. That the organizers are responsible for arranging barricade volunteers for all barricade locations.
4. That all emergency and transit services are advised of the event.
5. That an emergency lane be maintained on the closed road during the event.
6. That the road closure be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the City of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
