1.0 INTRODUCTION

At the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission meeting held on 2019 June 11, correspondence (Attachment #1) was received from Mr. Berni James suggesting an initiative by the City of Burnaby to honour Ms. Christine Sinclair, Captain of the National Women's Soccer Team, who originates from Burnaby. 
Dear Mr Mayor & Council,
