WHEREAS The Job Plan introduced Advanced Manufacturing as one of four Job Plan sectors that are expected to see major growth in the coming years, creating sustainable, long-term, high-paying jobs for our next generation; and

WHEREAS Manufacturing provides well-paying, high-skilled employment opportunities to 174,200 people across the Province; and

WHEREAS Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME) and partner organizations such as boards of trades, chambers, academic institutions, municipal and provincial governments are presenting an intense calendar of events, workshops and 30 youth plant tours through the month of October to heighten the profile of manufacturing and reinforce that manufacturing professions and skilled trades occupations are inspiring and rewarding careers; and
