REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Burnaby Village Museum (BVM) is presenting Heritage Christmas from 2019 November 23 to 2020 January 03 (closed December 24 and 25). Admission is free to the public.

Attached is a request (<u>Attachment #1</u>) from Burnaby Community Services for their Burnaby Christmas Bureau program, seeking Commission approval for the donation of a portion of the Carousel ride revenue for charitable purposes. The BVM has extended hours from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m. from 2019 December 14 to 2020 January 03 (except for December 24 and 25). The period being considered is from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. on 2019 November 30.

In past years this request has been supported by Commission generating approximately \$1,000 in donated revenue to the Burnaby Christmas Bureau. The Museum allows member pass holders unlimited free carousel rides throughout the year and this would need to be honored.

Hello Mr. Dave Ellenwood,

Thank you for your ongoing support of Burnaby Community Services and our Burnaby Christmas Bureau program. I am writing to ask if you will continue to help families with low income, seniors experiencing isolation and those suffering with extreme poverty this Holiday Season through the generous donation of Carousel ticket sales during the first late night of the Heritage Christmas at the Burnaby Village Museum.

Through the generosity of our community, last year we distributed \$195,679 in holiday items to 3,525 people - including 1,550 children, 94 seniors and 67 unique individuals (those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness).

During my time with the Bureau the Burnaby Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services has been supporting us. First with the Loonie, then Toonie, and half price nights on the first late night of Heritage Christmas at the Burnaby Village Museum. Since 2011, with the introduction of free admission, ticket sales for the restored Carousel have been donated to the Bureau.

We would ask that the Burnaby Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services consider again supporting the Bureau by donating all carousel ticket sales during the Burnaby Village Museum's Heritage Christmas, Bright in Burnaby, on November 30th, 2019 from 5pm until 9pm.
