REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Recognition Night is an annual event hosted by the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission to recognize the important contribution that the volunteer community groups add to the provision of parks, recreational and cultural programs and services in the city. In 2019, Recognition Night took place on April 26 at the Riverway Golf Course Clubhouse with approximately 170 people in attendance.

The event continues to be popular with Burnaby's community organizations and the Riverway Clubhouse has proven to be a very successful venue.

The invitation criteria reflect that the community organizations provide a service or partnership role, which enhances the services provided by our department.

The invitation criteria are as follows:

1. The purpose of Recognition Night is to honour representatives from not-for-profit groups that provide a significant benefit to the community through the provision of parks, recreation and cultural services either through a partnership or as a service, which enhances that offered by the department.
