#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

An application request for \$6,000.00 has been received from the Mali Kurdistanian Society for their Kurdish New Year Nawruz. It is held on 2020 March 21 at Barnet Marine Park, Burnaby. Nawruz is a traditional celebration of the upcoming spring and New Year for the Kurds across the world. More than 3,000 Kurds in the Metro Vancouver and environs centralize their celebrations at Mali Kurdistanian Society. This day-long festivities include dancing, singing, musical performances on different stages, poetry readings, a variety of original Kurdish and Kurdish-inspired foods and drinks, family activities and picnics. It is an event that welcomes different communities including Baloch, Persians and Afghanistan populations as well as non Kurdish Canadians.
