1.0 INTRODUCTION

An application request for \$6,000.00 has been received from the Vancouver Cantonese Opera for The Bamboo Theatre: A Cantonese Opera Festival on 2020 May 30 at the Michael J. Fox Theatre. The Bamboo Theatre takes inspiration from the historic festivals held in China, where travelling opera troupes roamed the countryside. The villagers would build a temporary open-air bamboo stage at a crossroads or grassy field, attracting audiences from near and far. The opera's uplifting tales sparked conversations and strengthened community bonds around shared values of compassion, friendship and iustice.

Cantonese opera is a unique combination of performing arts including singing, dancing, acting, miming and acrobatic movements.

The mission of the Vancouver Cantonese Opera is to present the unique traditional art of Cantonese opera to both Chinese and non-Chinese audiences. As an organization they strive for artistic excellence; host educational seminars and workshops; offer accessible, affordable and entertaining performances; and provide employment opportunities to Cantonese opera artists, musicians and technicians. Vancouver Cantonese Opera produced their first Cantonese opera in 2000 and since then has produced over 23 Cantonese Opera long plays and other Cantonese based performances throughout Metro Vancouver.
