BYLAW NO. 14215

A BYLAW to close and remove the dedication of
a certain portion of highway

WHEREAS pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter* and section 120 of the *Land Title Act*, Council may by bylaw close part of a highway to traffic and remove the dedication of that part of the highway;

AND WHEREAS Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic and remove the dedication of that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HIGHWAY CLOSURE BYLAW NO. 3, 2020.**
2. ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as parts on road dedicated on Explanatory Plans 13121, 13162, 13503, 14330, 15067 and Plan 32447 all of District Lot 129 Group 1 New Westminster District, and identified as “CLOSED ROAD”, as shown outlined in bold on Reference Plan EPP86166 (hereinafter called “the closed portion of road”), prepared by Jason G. Hamel, B.C.L.S., a copy of which is hereunto annexed, is hereby closed to all types of traffic.

3. The dedications of the closed portions of road as highway are removed.
