

CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 14295

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY VOTING OPPORTUNITIES BYLAW 2020, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2021.**
2. Burnaby Voting Opportunities Bylaw 2020 is amended:

(a) at section 2.1, by adding the following in alphabetical order:

“seniors’ care facility” means a seniors’ acute, intermediate and/or extended care facility or seniors’ independent living facility that is located within the **City**

“special voting opportunity” has the meaning set out in the *Local Government Act*

(b) by adding the following after section 3.3:

“PART 4: SPECIAL VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

- 4.1 In order to give electors who may otherwise be unable to vote an opportunity to do so, **special voting opportunities** may be established at **seniors’ care facilities**.
- 4.2 Only electors who are residents of the **seniors’ care facility** at which a **special voting opportunity** is established may vote at the **special voting opportunity**.
- 4.3 Subject to the *Local Government Act*, the **Chief Election Officer** is hereby authorized to:
 - (a) establish the **seniors’ care facility** or **seniors’ care facilities** at which a **special voting opportunity** will be conducted and the date and voting hours for each **special voting opportunity**; and
 - (b) limit the number of candidate representatives who may be present at a **special voting opportunity**.”
