• A member from Kingsway and Edmonds area observes positive change and improvements in his neighbourhood. Newly placed street signs and increased police presence in the area are very appreciated by the community.

• A member reported on the spike in cyber-fraud attempts observed both in his personal life as well as the observation being shared by his customers and nearby businesses. CPAC #3 has approached Victim Services for a presentation on Online Security and Safety and Scams.
