SUBJECT: BURNABY VILLAGE MUSEUM UPDATES

Burnaby Village Museum will be hosting its annual Neighbourhood Speaker Series in partnership with Burnaby Public Libraries. Due to last years overwhelming popularity in its digital platform, the Series is expanding to semi-annual for 2021. The spring series will be hosted in late April and early May and will focus on "Indigenous Voices". Talks will focus on decolonizing, land acknowledgement, Indigenous plant knowledge and Indigenous art and will offer participants an opportunity to explore Indigenous ways of knowing.
