NATIONAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLES DAY

Whereas National Indigenous Peoples Day is an opportunity for all Canadians to celebrate the unique heritage and diverse cultures of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples; and

WHEREAS Burnaby is located on the ancestral and unceded homelands of the hə́nqəmínəm and Skwxwú7mesh speaking peoples; and

WHEREAS We recognize this day as part of the City's broader efforts to advance truth and reconciliation and renew relationships with Indigenous peoples, based on recognition of rights, respect, cooperation and partnership.
