WHEREAS Around 1-in-6 older people experience some form of abuse, a figure higher than previously estimated and predicted to rise as populations age worldwide; and

WHEREAS Rates of abuse may be higher for older people living in institutions than in the community; and

WHEREAS Elder abuse can lead to serious physical injuries and long-term psychological consequences; and

WHEREAS The City of Burnaby respects and values our senior citizens and supports them in leading safe, healthy and active lives free from neglect or abuse.
