One day, I called them to book a room Sec. Sec. 22 (1) they do asked me if I would need to drink there. I thought they had a liquor license, so I was asking about the price. Sec. 22 (1) told me, the price is \$1200 minimum charge per room, and I can choose any liquor I want. Just let them know before we come, so they can prepare earlier. That was pricey for me, so I said no, but obviously they do provide drinking servicing illegally.
