1. CALL TO ORDER

2. MINUTES

2.1 <u>Minutes of the Planning and Development Committee Open meeting held on 2021 June 29</u>

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3. REPORTS

3.1 Report from Director Planning and Building Re: Burnaby Transportation Plan Update: Draft Burnaby Transportation Plan

The Director Planning and Building submitted a report seeking Council approval of the draft Burnaby Transportation Plan, "Connecting Burnaby" as the basis for advancing the Phase 3 public consultation and engagement program, as outlined in Section 5.0 of this report.

The Director Planning and Building recommended:

- 1. THAT the Committee recommend that Council approve the attached draft Burnaby Transportation Plan "Connecting Burnaby" as the basis for advancing the Phase 3 public consultation and engagement program, as outlined in Section 5.0 of this report.
- 2. THAT this report be sent to the Environment, Public Safety, Social Planning, and Traffic Safety Committee for information.

Staff provided the Committee with an overview of the Draft Burnaby Transportation Plan.

Arising from the presentation, the Committee requested the following changes:

- increase the number of bus shelters and benches, expedite the implementation time, and more frequent maintenance of benches and shelters to encourage transit use;
- provide washroom amenities at SkyTrain stations and major bus loops;
- prioritize sidewalk improvement areas, and include seniors residences in addition to seniors centres;
- utilize 'City Connect' to inform residents of the plans for the sidewalk improvements to increase walkability in the City;
- prioritize separated paths verses multi-use paths;
- include a bike share program;
- increase bus connections between Sperling SkyTrain Station and Hastings Street, enabling direct access between the proposed Lochdale and Bainbridge Urban Villages;
- ensure bus transit to SFU remains a priority;

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- investigate a West Coast Express stop in Burnaby, possibly around Willingdon; and
- ensure that public transit remains a priority on Canada Way and Hastings Street; and
- ensure that young families are encouraged to engage in the consultation process.

Arising from further discussion, the following motion was introduced:

THAT His Worship, Mayor Hurley, on behalf of Council, write a letter to TransLink requesting that the public washrooms at the Metrotown SkyTrain Station be made immediately available for general use.

3.2 Report from Director Planning and Building Re: Framework for Establishing Temporary Use Permits and Processes

The Director Planning and Building submitted a report seeking Council authorization for staff to bring forward a framework to establish the use of Temporary Use Permits, and define a procedure for the review and issuance of Temporary Use Permits.

The Director Planning and Building recommended:

1. THAT the Committee request Council authorize staff to bring forward a report to propose amendments to the Burnaby Zoning Bylaw, 1965, that permits the use of Temporary Use Permits, and the Burnaby Planning and Building Fees Bylaw, 2017, to include a new application fee for the Temporary Use Permit applications, and to establish the Burnaby Development Procedures Bylaw to define a procedure for the review and issuance of the Temporary Use Permits.

3.3 Report from the Director Planning and Building Re: Proposed Amendment to the Montecito Community Plan

The Director Planning and Building submitted a report seeking endorsement of a proposed amendment to the Montecito Community Plan, in association with a proposed rezoning to develop a four-unit multi-family residential building at 1508 Hatton Avenue (Rezoning Reference #19-51).

The Director Planning and Building recommended:

- 1. THAT the Committee recommend Council endorse the proposed amendment to the Montecito Community Plan, as described in Section 3.0 of this report, as the basis for public consultation.
- 2. THAT the Committee recommend Council authorize staff to undertake a public consultation process, as described in Section 5.0 of this report.
