A BYLAW to set fees and charges for
financial administration services

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW 2013, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2021.**
2. Burnaby Financial Administration Fees and Charges Bylaw 2013, as amended, is further amended by deleting Schedule “A” in its entirety and replacing it with Schedule “A” attached hereto.
3. This Bylaw comes into force on January 1, 2022.
