A BYLAW to impose Parks, Recreation and Culture fees

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURE FEES BYLAW 2022.
- 2. The City of Burnaby imposes facility rental, admission and equipment fees for Parks, Recreation and Culture facilities and equipment in accordance with Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 3. Where applicable, taxes will be added to the fees specified in Schedule "A" of this bylaw.
- 4. The following bylaws, and all subsequent amendments thereto, are hereby repealed:
 - (a) Burnaby Shadbolt Centre and Burnaby Art Gallery Rental Fees Bylaw 2019 (Bylaw No. 14207);
 - (b) Burnaby Village Museum Fees Bylaw 2019 (Bylaw No. 14208); and
 - (c) Burnaby Recreation Fees and Admissions Bylaw 2021 (Bylaw No. 14336).
- 5. This bylaw comes into force and effect on January 1, 2022.
