

BYLAW NO. 14550

A BYLAW to remove the park dedication of a portion of Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park

WHEREAS pursuant *Burnaby Park Dedication Bylaw 2005* (Bylaw No. 11988), those lands having a municipal address of 4800 Riverbend Drive were dedicated for park and recreation uses as part of what is commonly known as “Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park” by an affirmative vote of at least 2/3 of all the members of Council;

WHEREAS Council of the City of Burnaby now wishes to remove the park dedication from that 8.43 hectare portion of 4800 Riverbend Drive shown on the plan attached to this Bylaw as Schedule A (the “Park Dedication Removal Area”);

WHEREAS pursuant to section 30(3) of the *Community Charter*, a bylaw that removes a reservation or dedication of property as a park may only be adopted with the approval of the electors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY PARK DEDICATION REMOVAL BYLAW 2023**.
2. The park dedication for the Park Dedication Removal Area is hereby removed.
